IT apps to enable remote learning to take place for all pupils. Purchase Seesaw Pro licences	Years R – 6 250 pupils x whole school licence	Ensuring that a remote platform is available for high quality teaching and feedback for any bubbles that are self-isolating or in case of a whole school closure.
Support pupils without access to a home learning device or Wi-Fi. Purchase a library of tablet devices with hot spots.	x 20 iPads and covers x1 iPad trolley	Children are not disadvantaged by lack of technology and in case of a bubble closure do not have their learning disrupted.
Additional interventions for phonics	Teacher x2 days per week (Jan – July 2021)	Phonics intervention sessions for identified pupils in order to accelerate progress.
Mental health training for key staff member who will then disseminate to all staff so that they can support pupils with their mental wellbeing.	x1 training course	Provide staff with the skills to support pupils' mental health and emotional well-being during the pandemic, especially linked to DV.
Blended RWI training for all staff to plug reading gaps for all pupils in EYFS/KS1 and bottom 20% in KS2. Including access to teaching videos.	Blended training package	To improve the quality of early reading provision.
Mr ICT P licence to support staff subject knowledge of IT, especially Seesaw.	Whole school licence	Ensure that staff have access to IT training, including Seesaw in order to improve the quality of remote learning.





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Purchase clicker 8 to support the literacy and language skills of pupils, especially SEND.	Whole school licence	Ensure that we continue to develop language and literacy skills for our pupils, providing additional scaffolding for SEND pupils.
