#### At school we will:

Ensure that children understand our SMARTER CODE.

Ensure that school staff set a high standard of behaviour.

Share with you our school behaviour policy.

Ensure that all children are given opportunities to earn rewards for showing exceptional behaviour consistently.

Care and respect the grounds, buildings, furniture and equipment and books provided at school.

#### At home we will:

### CURRICULUM and HOMEWORK

#### At school we will:

Set appropriate homework regularly.

Ensure children have high quality home reading books, matched to their reading ability.

#### At home we will:

Read with our children at least three times a week and record this in our child's reading diary.

### ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

#### At school we will:

Request reasons for any absence or lateness.

Liaise with Educational Welfare Officer about poor attendance.

#### At home we will:

Make sure our children are in school everyday by 8.45am and collected on time at the end of the school day.

Contact the school office if our child is absent by 9am on the first day.

### CARE AND COMMUNICATION

#### At school we will:

Communicate school news regularly, through letters, emails and social media.

Keep you informed about your child's progress and attainment.

Teach your child how to have a healthy, safe and happy lifestyle.

#### At home we will:

Ensure school has an up to date contact telephone numbers.

Attend parents evening to discuss my child's progress and attainment.

Communicate any concerns we have about our child's learning, behaviour or well-being our class teacher.
