This is part of our graduated approach, in which we **Assess, Plan, Do, Review**. This ongoing cycle ensures that effective provision is put in place and removes barriers to learning. We have a range of interventions taking place daily in our school to meet the needs of all our children. We believe in **inclusivity** for all and strive to make this a reality for all our pupils.

SEND Review Meetings



This term, parents evening will be taking place on Tuesday 26th November. At this meeting, your child's **first SEND review** for this school year will take place. Your child's Autumn term targets will be shared (**Plan**) and the provision that has been put in place in order for your child to achieve their targets. (**Do**). Your child's class teacher will then discuss the outcomes of the targets (**Review and Assess**) and share next steps for the Spring term. At these meetings, it is a great opportunity to ask any questions and discuss any concerns you may have.

A copy of your child's Autumn 2024-2025 provision map will be sent home after this meeting.

SEND Parents Evening

On Wednesday 3rd December, I will be available to speak to parents who would like to discuss their child's needs further. These appointments are not just for parents whose child is on the SEND register but is for any parent who may have SEND concerns about their child.
