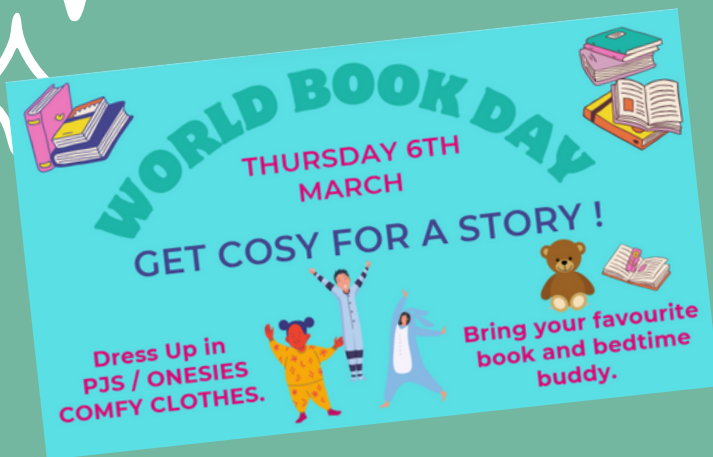

READING GNOME DELIVERIES

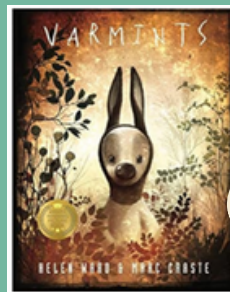
EVERY CLASS HAS RECEIVED DELIVERIES OF RECOMMENDED BOOKS FROM THE READING GNOME.
